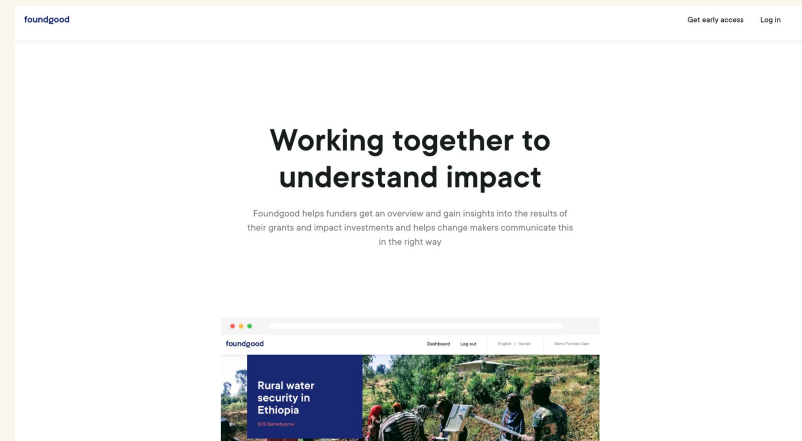

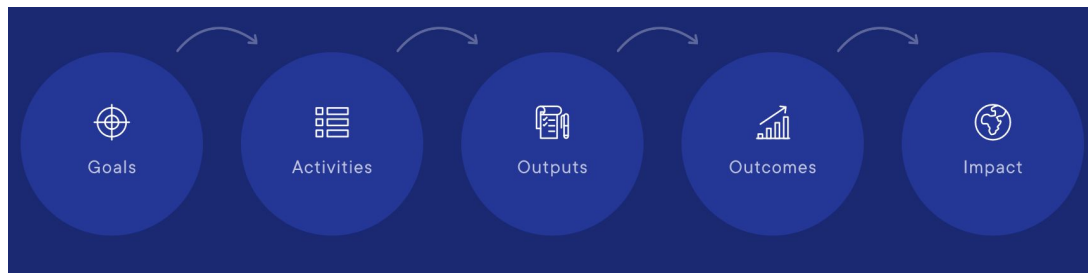

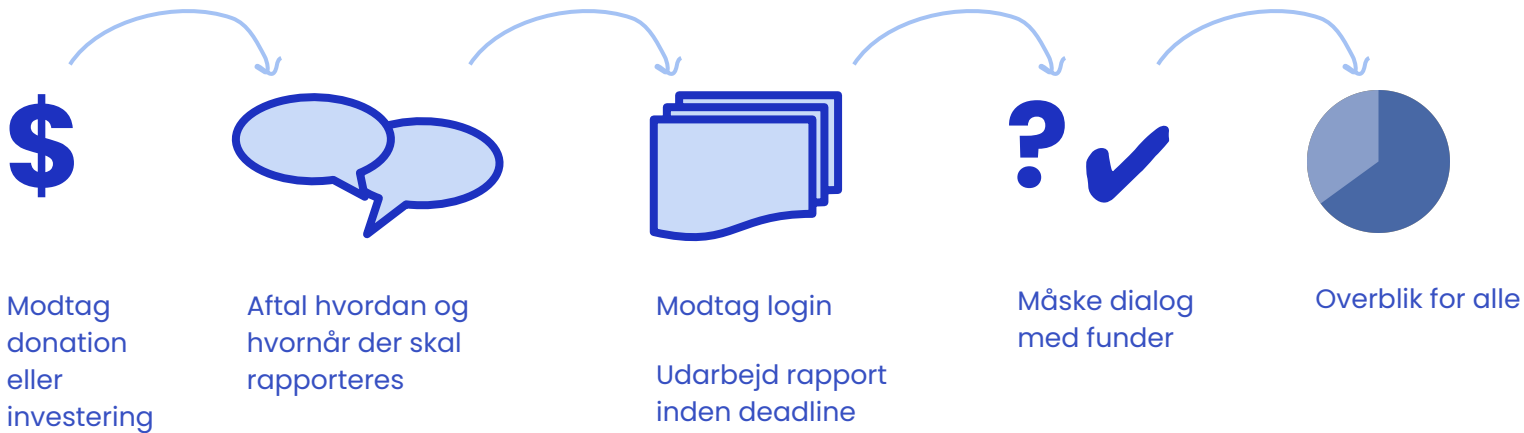
Logik i sin kerne

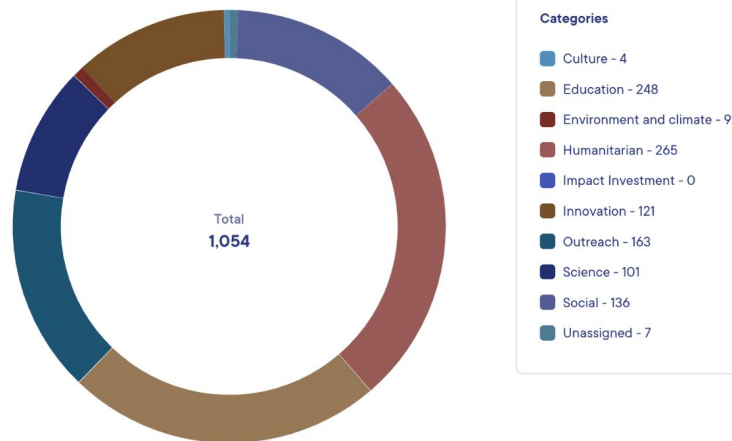
